The Michael Moore Memorial Scholarship Fund has been created in memory of Michael, a former member and volunteer of YMCA Northumberland. Michael Moore was a dedicated YMCA member, well known for his time spent playing basketball, soccer and working-out. Michael, along with his father Robin, was an enthusiastic volunteer and established our floor hockey program at the Cobourg YMCA in 1999. Michael lost his life in a tragic car accident in January of 2000.

This scholarship has been developed with the input, care and devotion of Michael's family to keep his actions and commitment to YMCA values alive and to help other young people reach their goals. The purpose of the Michael Moore Memorial Scholarship Fund is to assist students currently volunteering or working at YMCA Northumberland to pursue studies at post-secondary institutions in the field of study of their choice.

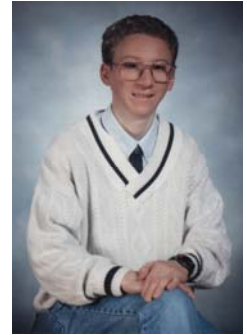

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Award Criteria

- Applicants must currently be volunteers or employees of YMCA Northumberland in the delivery of programs and services.
- Applicants can be entering post-secondary studies, or are already enrolled in full or part-time studies at a post-secondary institution.
- Candidates will be chosen based on their contribution to YMCA Northumberland, financial need, as well as their demonstrated commitment to the YMCA core values of caring, respect, honesty, responsibility, honesty, health and citizenship.
- Selection of the candidates will be conducted by a committee comprised of a maximum of 6 appointed voting members: a maximum of 2 members of the Moore Family, a maximum of 2 staff and a maximum of 2 policy volunteers and chaired by the Director of Development (the Director of Development will be a non-voting member). The CEO of the YMCA and the Chair of the Board of Directors are ex-officio members of the selection committee. The committee members will be appointed by the Director of Development on a 2 year rotation cycle.
- An individual is eligible to receive this award only once from YMCA Northumberland.
- A minimum amount of \$800 per year will be awarded towards a minimum of one chosen students' undergraduate or post graduate studies.
- YMCA Northumberland will require proof of acceptance into a post-secondary program before releasing funds and will require the chosen student to send a letter at some point during their school year outlining their progress.
- YMCA Northumberland accepts and encourages private donations to the Michael Moore Memorial YMCA Scholarship at any time.

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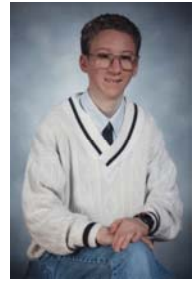
